Range Sign-Up to be Removed January 2

The pistol and rifle range on-line sign-up, in use since May 23 when the ranges re-opened from mandated COVID-19 closures, will be removed effective Saturday, January 2. Members using the ranges during open range hours (1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Saturdays and Sundays when ranges are staffed by Duty Range Officers) will no longer be required to complete advance reservations.

The on-line sign-up was used in conjunction with the Supplemental Range Rules to moderate traffic flow at the ranges. After analysis of open range hours usage, the Range Safety Committee determined social distancing safety measures can still be maintained without the advance sign-up. The Supplemental Range Rules remain in effect that limit available pistol range shooting positions to four and rifle range positions to one. Per the Supplemental Range Rules (available at www.iwlar.org and posted at the ranges), Duty Range Officers may limit shooting times if persons are waiting for a shooting position.
