

**Izaak Walton League Rockville Chapter (IWLAR)
2021 SUMMER ARCHERY PROGRAM & PROTOCOLS**

DATES:

- June 6th**; Orientation and Safety Presentation (Mandatory for participation)
- June 13th, 20th, 27th; Regular Sessions
- NO SESSION July 4th
- July 11th, 18th; Regular Sessions

PLAN:

- NO 8-10yo (little kid's) range
- 2 Sessions:
 - Session 1: 12:30-1:30pm; Beginners only; 15 person limit
 - Session 2: 2:00-3:00pm; Returning archers only; 20 person limit
 - There will be a 30-minute break in between sessions to conduct cleaning protocols and an instructor break

**NOTE: June 6 has a modified time schedule (1 ½ Hours for each session):

- Session 1: Noon-1:30pm
- Session 2: 2:00-3:30pm
- 5 Archers at a time will be allowed on the line
- Each archer will be assessed and assigned a bow and color-coded arrows for his/her use during each session.
- Upon arrival at each session, each archer will be checked in, assigned a number ranging from 1-4, depending on the number of archers participating in the session, and a color of arrows. The numbers will designate when the archers will be called to come forward to shoot. This check-in sheet will also be used in the event someone gets sick, in order to contact trace.
- The bow-trees and active shooting area will be roped off and will have an instructor monitoring the entrance to the area.
- When a group is called to come forward to shoot, they will check in with the line monitor. The line monitor will check to make sure the archer is in the correct group and have them use hand sanitizer. The archers will then go and get their bow and arrows and go to the line.
- Before shooting, archers will remove their masks (for safety reasons) and secure them in a pocket (they cannot be put on the wrist). Instructors will wear their masks at all times, but will have to be closer than the recommended 6ft.

- Once the archers are finished shooting, they will put their mask back on and then leave the active shooting area, putting their equipment in their designated area. Archers will not touch anyone else's equipment.
- Once line is safe, instructors will retrieve arrows (wipe down if necessary) and the next group will then be called up.
- In between sessions, equipment and facilities will be cleaned.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION. PLEASE READ AND PLAN ACCORDINGLY:

- Water will not be provided this summer. Please bring your own full water bottle.
- Children 12 and under need to have a supervising adult present during the entire session.
- Please bring your own lawn chairs/blankets. No seating will be provided and plan on staying with your family unit and distancing your seating area at least 6ft. from others.
- No finger tabs, arm guards, bug spray, etc. will be provided.
- If you are bringing/using your own equipment, you are required to mark your bow and arrows in some way that it is easily identifiable. (We will give more guidance on this during the safety session or prior to arrival.)
- Parents/guardians are responsible for monitoring their children when they are not on the line shooting to ensure safe distancing and current health/safety protocols.
