# Lake Rules

These rules are intended to help the Chapter maintain a safe and enjoyable time for all Members when using the lake area. Your cooperation is appreciated.

1. **Membership** - All Members must display their membership cards while at the lake.
2. **Activities** - No swimming, wading or ice-skating are allowed at any time.
3. **Trash** - The lake is a "No Trash" area. All trash must be removed upon exiting.
4. **Boats** - No boats or other flotation devices are permitted in the lake except for special activities approved by the Board of Directors or a Lake Chairman. Radio controlled boats are not allowed.
5. **Camping** - Camping is permitted. No camping is permitted under the pavilion.
6. **Fires** - Open fires are permitted ONLY in designated fire pits located at the pavilion, the pier and the campsite at the north end of the lake.  
**Fire safety MUST be observed** including; no excessively large fires, all fires must be attended and all fires must be extinguished prior to the Member leaving the lake area. No fires are allowed during dry or windy conditions. State and/or County fire bans must to be followed.
7. **Fishing** - Creel limit for trout is three (3) fish per day per Member (includes guests' catch). Bass and Catfish are catch and release only.
8. **Number of Rods** - No more than two (2) rods of any type with no more than two (2) hooks on each line may be used at one time.
9. **Release of Wildlife** - No wildlife may be released in the lake area without prior approval of a Lake Chairman.
10. **Gate** - A Chapter issued electronic access card is required to unlock the lake gate. The gate must be closed and locked upon entering and leaving. Exceptions will be made with prior approval from the Board of Directors and/or a Lake Chairman for special events.
11. **Gate Access** - Members who supply their access card to non-members (including their own children) will be subject to cancellation of their Chapter membership.
12. **Guests** - Only five guests per Member are allowed unless authorized by the Board of Directors or a Lake Chairman.
13. **Bridge** - No running or jumping on bridge. No more than four people on the bridge at any time.
14. **Debris in lake** - No rocks, sticks or other material are to be thrown into the lake.
15. **Firearms** - No firearms, air guns, slingshots, paint balls or similar items are allowed at any time.
16. **Archery** - Archery equipment may only be used in connection with hunting activities authorized by the Grounds Chairman.
17. **Motorized Vehicles** - Only road legal licensed vehicles are permitted. No ATV's, go carts, dirt bikes or similar vehicles are allowed.
18. **Use of Facilities** - The use of the pavilion, picnic areas, fire pits and other facilities is on a first come first served basis. Exceptions may be made for prearranged activities approved by the Board of Directors or Lake Chairman.
19. **Pets** - Pets are permitted but must be on leash at all times. The owner must remove all waste.
20. **Members Under 18** - No Member under the age of 18 is allowed at the lake unless accompanied by a Member 21 years of age or older.
21. **Members Under 21** - No Member under the age of 21 is allowed at the lake between dusk and dawn unless accompanied by a Member 21 years of age or older.
22. **Minors** - Members supplying alcohol or illegal substances to minors will be subject to cancellation of their Chapter membership and will be subject to any and all applicable laws.
23. **Rules Violations** - Members in violation of the lake rules will be asked to leave the area and will be subject to cancellation of their Chapter membership.
24. **Reporting** - All violations must be reported to the Board of Directors and a Lake Chairman.
25. **Laws** - All State and County laws pertaining to alcohol, drugs, firearms and fireworks are applicable. Individuals in violation of State and/or County laws will be prosecuted.
