The Izaak Walton League of America - a non-profit conservation organization - is recognized as a Section 501(c)(3) public charity under the Internal Revenue Code. Minimum National dues are \$50 for individuals and \$70 for family memberships, which include \$4 for Outdoor America magazine. Magazine is inseparable from dues. Chapter and Division dues may vary. NOTE: All dues are included in the above Annual Dues and Fee Schedules.

#### Membership Application—Dues and Fee Schedules

- Candidates for membership MUST attend an Orientation meeting which is by invitation only, through the Membership Secretary.
- After the Orientation, candidates will present themselves to the Board of Directors (BoD)
- If accepted by the BoD, candidates will be **sworn in at the following General Membership meeting**, which are generally held on the first Friday of the following month
- Dues are based on the month in which you are **sworn in**. **If you are submitting your application in JUNE, you will** pay the appropriate 1.5 year dues, as the next General Membership meeting is in July
- In order to use any range, a member must first complete the Range Safety class

<sup>\*</sup>The Initiation Fee is a ONE TIME fee. It is waived for active members transferring from another IWLA Chapter and Students upgrading to full membership. The initiation fee is waived for active-duty military, law enforcement officers, fire fighters and other first responders.
